## NOTICE TO THE BAR AND THE PUBLIC REGARDING REVISION TO APPENDIX O – LOCAL FORM NOTICE OF SALE OF ESTATE PROPERTY

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Appendix O, Local Form Notice of Sale of Estate

Property, to the Bankruptcy Court's Local Rules has been revised and there are new forms that

are required to be used, effective immediately. After implementing Local Rules 6004-1 and
6004-2, the Bankruptcy Court continued to review Appendix O so that it now consists of four (4)
separate Notices of Proposed Sale that might be used in connection with a sale of estate property.

The intention is that the forms will be more self-explanatory and user-friendly.

**Effective immediately**, the four Local Form Notices of Sale of Estate Property are as follows:

- (i) Notice of Proposed **Private Sale** of Estate Property
- (ii) Notice of Proposed **Public Sale** of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. **6004-1(a)**
- (iii) Notice of Order Granting Motion For **Private Sale** of Estate Property
- (iv) Notice of Order Granting Motion for **Public Sale** of Estate Property pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. **6004-1(b)**

The Process Pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a). For a sale of property following D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a), either Local Form Notice of Proposed Private Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.A1) or Local Form Notice of Proposed Public Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.A2) must be completed, filed, and served pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(a)(2). Each form for the sale process contemplated in D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(a) must include information supporting the proposed consideration, the evidence of value of the property, and the efforts undertaken to obtain a higher and better purchase price. *Before* filing a Notice of Proposed Private or Public Sale of Estate Property, information to complete the form must be obtained from the Clerk's Office, including a sale date, hearing date and time, and, an objection deadline. The Process Pursuant to D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b). For a sale of property following D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b), either Local Form Notice of Order Granting Motion for Private Sale (Local Form CTB-LF238.B1) or Local Form Notice of Order Granting Motion for Public Sale of Estate Property (Local Form CTB-LF238.B2) must be completed in accordance with D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b) and shall be filed only after a hearing is held and an order enters approving a sale of property free and clear of liens, approving sale procedures, or entering other appropriate relief related to a sale consistent with D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b).

CM/ECF events. Additional CM/ECF events have been added under the "Notices" menu category title: (1) "Notice 6004-1(a) – Notice of Proposed Private/Public Sale" and "Notice 6004-1(b) - Notice of Order Granting Motion for Private/Public Sale". The events allow the filer to select whether the form is referencing a private or public sale of estate property. The docket text will reflect the selections made during the event.

Notice of Order Granting Motion for <b>Public Sale</b> of Estate Property  D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b)	This Notice shall be completed after a hearing in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(c) and (f) and D. Conn. Bankr. L. R. 6004-1(b).	Objection date and hearing date to be assigned by the court after a hearing.	This Notice shall be completed and filed only <i>after a hearing</i> on a Motion to Sell Estate Property, Motion to Sell Estate Property Free and Clear of Liens, and/or Motion to Approve Procedures to Sell Estate Property is held by the Court.
